The Parliament of Zimbabwe will be responsible for the local ground transport arrangements for the delegates. Any transport requirements outside the Conference Programme will be regarded as private and delegates will be expected to meet the cost of such services

Conference languages will be English, French and Portuguese

### REGISTRATION

**OPENING CEREMONY** 

The Conference will be officially opened on 28 May 2023, at the Elephant Hotel, Victoria Falls.

Registration of delegates will be at the Registration Desk which will be located at the Elephant Hotel on 25 May 2023.

All delegates, support staff and the APLESA Secretariat will be issued with identity badges on registration. These badges are expected to be worn throughout the conference period for purposes of security, ease of identification and to facilitate access into the Conference venue.

#### **SECURITY AND ACCREDITATION**

The Parliament of Zimbabwe in conjunction with the Government of Zimbabwe, through its security agencies, will provide security to the delegates based on international practice throughout the duration of the Conference.

Zimbabwe uses the British 3 pin square plug. The Voltage is 240v

#### **Medical Services**

Delegates will be responsible for their medical expenses. However, Parliament of Zimbabwe will provide basic medical facilities for minor ailments for the duration of the conference. Major cases will be referred to established health facilities at the expense of the delegate. Those with chronic ailments, are reminded to pack their medication before they travel. Delegates are also kindly requested to engage their medical aid societies to secure travel insurance cover before they travel to Victoria Falls

## **CURRENCY CONVERSION**

#### **CURRENCY EXCHANGE**

Zimbabwe operates under a mono-currency dispensation under Real Time Gross Settlement (RTGS) dollar. International delegates can also make use of the major international currencies, namely the United States Dollar, the British Pound Sterling, the Euro and the South African Rand. The currency in Zimbabwe is the RTGS dollar which is currently pegged at RTGS 16 to the United States Dollar.

Banks and bureaus de change open at 0800 hours and close at 1500 hours during the week and on Saturday open at 0800 hours and close at 1100 hours.

Please also note that the exchange rate can change anytime depending on the demand. Delegates are, therefore, advised to carry with them enough cash or loaded visa card for comfortable sustenance.

#### International

Debit cards (Visa and MasterCard) are acceptable in Zimbabwe.

#### Weather

The climate in Victoria Falls during the month of May is warm and very dry. May is in the fall / autumn in Victoria Falls. Daytime maximum temperatures average around a comfortable 29° Celcius and 11° Celcius at night. It is recommended that you bring a mixture of both light and heavy clothing


