21ST ANNUAL CONFERENCE OF THE ASSOCIATION OF PARLIAMENTARY LIBRARIES OF EASTERN AND SOUTHERN AFRICA (APLESA), 18 – 25 MAY 2024

MAPUTO – MOÇAMBIQUE



I. INTRODUCTION

The Assembly of the Republic (Assembleia da República – AR) of Mozambique welcomes member delegations of the Association of Parliamentary Libraries of Eastern and Southern Africa (APLESA) to Maputo, Republic of Mozambique, where they will have the opportunity to participate in the 21st Annual Conference of the Association of Parliamentary Libraries of Eastern and Southern Africa (APLESA), to be held in May 2024.

Therefore, we are pleased to share the informative circular intended to guide delegates and other Conference participants during their stay in Maputo.

II. DATES and VENUE

The 21st Annual Conference and Meeting of the Association of Parliamentary Libraries of Eastern and Southern Africa (APLESA) will be organized by the Parliament of the Republic of Mozambique from **18 to 25 May 2024**. The meeting venue will be the **Southern Sun Hotel**.

III. FLIGHT DETAIL

Flights to Mozambique can be operated by the following airlines: **Ethiopian Airlines, Air Link, Qatar Airways** and **LAM**.

We advise participants to communicate the details of their flights to the AR of Mozambique in advance to create logistical and protocol conditions.

III.I DATE of ARRIVAL

All delegates will arrive in Maputo, Mozambique, through the Maputo International Airport. The official arrival date for Executive Committee Members is **18 May 2024**. The Committee will meet on **19 May 2024**.

All other delegates are expected on 19 May 2024.

III.II DEPARTURE

Transportation from your hotel to the airport will be provided on the official departure day.

The official departure date for all delegates is 24 May 2024. The Executive Committee Members are expected to leave on 25 May 2024.



IV. CURRENCY and BAKING

The national currency of Mozambique is the Metical (MZM) which consists of notes (MZM 1,000.00; MZM 500.00; MZM 200.00; MZM 100.00; MZM 50.00 and MZM 20.00) and coins (MZM 10.00; MZM 5.00; MZM 2.00; MZM 1.00 and cents 0.50).

The current exchange rate for USD is approximately USD 1 = METICAL 64,00 (March 2024). Foreign currency can be exchanged at commercial banks, some hotels, and foreign exchange agents and at Maputo International Airport.

All major international credit cards are generally accepted in hotels, shops and restaurants.

Most banks and bureaus de change are open between 08H 30 and 15H 00 from Mondays to Fridays, on Saturdays open at 08H 00, and close at 13H 00. Baking services are available at all commercial banks. Most banks have cash dispensing machines accepting Visa and MasterCard.

V. ACCOMMODATION

Participants are required to arrange their accommodation for their stay in Maputo. The Host Parliament has selected several hotels in Maputo as official hotels for accommodation choices that can suit one's budget. We highly recommend the following hotels for your convenience: Hotel África, City Lodge, Hotel Kapital, Otia Hotel, Stay Easy, Stay Inn, Hotel Southern Sun, Hotel Términus and Villa das Mangas.

VI. VISA REQUIREMENTS

All passengers entering Mozambique must have a valid passport for up to 6 months, a return or onward travel ticket and a completed arrival form.

To obtain a Mozambican Visa, applicants need to contact the nearest diplomatic/consular mission of the Republic of Mozambique.



Countries with no Mozambican Embassy will be granted visas upon arrival. If delegates do not get entry visas before departure, arrangements have been made to issue some upon arrival. The Protocol at Maputo International Airport will assist delegates as they go through entry formalities.

If a personalized invitation is needed to obtain a visa, please send a list with names of all delegates to the Secretariat in Mozambique Parliament for necessary action.

Delegates are hereby reminded to fill out and return Form B concerning travel details as soon as possible.

All visitors to the Republic of Mozambique, who, according to the World Health Organization, come from areas affected by yellow fever, must have a Yellow Fever Vaccination Card.

It is also advisable to carry a Covid-19 vaccination card.

VII. MEDICAL SERVICES

First-aid services staff will be available at the Conference venue.

MEDICAL PRECAUTIONS and HEALTH and TRAVEL INSURANCE

- All medical services will be at the participant's own expense.
- Participants are strongly advised to take out insurance to cover travel and medical expenses. Please ensure that you have the appropriate travel and medical insurance.
- Delegates on prescribed medication for special health reasons should bring adequate supplies with them.
- Delegates are hereby advised to take precautionary measures against malaria.

The meeting Secretariat of the Host Parliament must be informed of specific medical or other indications (dietary needs, allergy, limited mobility) as soon as possible (this information may be included during the participation confirmation), so that the necessary precautions or measures can be taken.

VIII. TRANSPORT

The Assembly of the Republic will be responsible for transporting guests, from the Airport to the Hotels and from there to the event location and vice versa.



IX. CLIMATE

During May dry weather is expected, the average temperature for the city of Maputo is a maximum of 26°C to 28°C and the minimum temperature is between 19°C to 21°C.

X. TIME

Mozambique time is GMT-1.

XI. TELECOMMUNICATION SERVICES

The telephone codes for the country and the city of Maputo, on landlines, are as follows:

- Mozambique: (+258) followed by nine digits;
- Cell phone code: (+258) followed by nine digits.

The following Mozambique mobile telecommunication service providers are available:

- Tmcel (+258 82/83)
- Vodacom (+258 84/85)
- Movitel (+258 86/87)

Mobile telephone service companies provide internet. Cell phone SIM cards are widely available. However, every SIM card user/byer in Maputo is expected by law to be registered for activation on presentation of an identification document (ID card or passport). The SIM card can be registered at the point of purchase

XII. BANK SERVICES

Bank opening hours are normally from **8:30 am** to **3:00 pm**. The main banks available are **Ecobank**; **Absa Bank Mozambique**; **Standard Bank Mozambique**; **Commercial and Investment Bank (BCI)**; **Nedbank Mozambique and Access Bank Mozambique**. Participants will be able to choose to use credit or debit cards in hotels, supermarkets and shopping centres.

XIII. ELECTRICITY

The power supply in Mozambique is **220V AC**, **50Hz**. The plug types are/is C and F, which is the plug that has two round pins.





XIV. VISITS TO THE MONUMENT

According to the program, a visit to the Matola Monument and Interpretation Center is planned. Entrance to the site is free, however, each participant can contribute some amount towards the maintenance of the monument.

XV. SHOPPING

To purchase regional and international crafts and items, delegates can visit the following locations:
